HG Widdowson, in his book "Teaching Language as Communication", presents the communicative approach as the main method in language teaching. He recommends creating situations similar to real-life communication in order to develop students' speaking skills.

D.Nunan, in his work "Language Teaching Methodology", discusses English language teaching methodologies and recommends encouraging students to speak through language games and exercises. M.Canale and M.Swain, in their work "Theoretical Bases of Communicative Approaches to Second Language Teaching and Testing", show the importance of communicative competence.
